APPROVAL OF MINUTES

LME REPORT – Daniel Hahn

- Youth Haven Services is now providing adult and child crisis services for the LME with on-sight services available at Caswell Mental Health. Youth Haven has also applied for endorsement to provide intensive in-home and community support services.
- Dan reported that the LME is moving toward tele-psychiatry for Crisis Services although there is no immediate timeframe for beginning this service.
- Dan noted that the LME recognizes the problem of the lack of providers in Caswell and is addressing this issue.
