The meeting was called to order by Tee Price, co-chair. There were two corrections to the minutes from the August 1, 2006, meeting. 1. Page 2, Item B2 – Change cover the placement to cover the treatment cost; 2. Page 2, Item G2 – Change possible to positive.

**MEETING:**

Due to this called meeting a motion was made to cancel the September 19, 2006, meeting by Terry Aiken and seconded by Cindi King. Motion carried. The meeting has been cancelled.

**SYSTEM OF CARE TRAINING:**

Ms. Windham passed out brochures regarding upcoming training in Charlotte, NC on September 18, 2006. This training is entitled “Working Together for Families”. **NON-UCR MONIES:**

A. Crisis care to prevent institutionalization.

Much discussion was held about item A., i.e. definition of crisis and time limit. It was recommended by Terry Aiken to send letters to all providers to see if they are interested in providing the Crisis Care. The amount of money agreed upon was 16,800.00. MOA will be given to the provider.

B. Comprehensive services and family supports.

B1. Residential placement for clients who are not eligible for Medicaid, Health Choice, etc. The amount of money agreed upon was 15,000.00. MOA will be given to the providers.

- B2. Client with a change in billing status with a lapse of coverage for treatment costs. The amount agreed upon was \$1,800.00. MOA will be given to the Mental Health Center.
  
- C. Family/Youth participation and...
  - C1. Peer support groups. The amount agreed upon was \$7,200.00. MOA will be given to the Mental Health Center.
  - C2. Family support groups. The amount agreed upon was \$2,000.00. MOA will be given to the Mental Health Center.
  - C3. Client scholarships to YMCA, etc. The amount agreed upon was \$3,000.00. MOA will be given to the Rockingham Consolidated Schools.
  - C4. Transportation for NA/AA activities, etc. The amount agreed upon was \$200.00. MOA will be given to the Mental Health Center.
  
- D. Community and family/youth training on System of Care, etc.
  - D1. Community Collaborative Cost. The amount agreed upon was \$2,000.00. MOA will be given to the Mental Health Center.
  - D2. SOC Training. The amount agreed upon was \$1,000.00. MOA will be given to the LME.
  
- G. Prevention and early intervention activities, etc.
  - G1. After-school prevention programs. The amount agreed upon was \$4,000.00. MOA will be given to Youth Services.
  - G2. Positive Behavior Support Program. The amount agreed upon was \$4,000.00. MOA will be given to Rockingham Consolidated Schools.
  - G3. Summer prevention program, etc. The amount agreed upon was \$3,000.00. MOA could be given to Youth Services in conjunction with Juvenile Court.

If during the year, there is a need to move some monies around, that can be addressed by the collaborative. Once the collaborative approves this transfer Ms. Windham would re-submit to the LME for final approval.

Ms. Windham will complete the final Non-UCR funding request and submit to the LME.

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Motion was made by Linda McMahan and seconded by Amy Tuttle to give the co-chairpersons authority to negotiate the plan as presented today with the stipulation that Crisis Care be no less than \$10,000 for FY 06-07. If the funds are reduced to less than \$10,000, a called meeting will be held for discussion. Motion carried.

Motion to adjourn was made by Linda McMahan and seconded by Terry Aiken. Motion carried.
