## WHAT IS ALAMANCE FAITH WEB?



***The story is told in Luke 5:17-26 of a helpless, paralyzed man who had good friends that were determined to get him help. They personally brought him to Jesus by tearing the hole in the roof of a home and lowering him in, where he was able to receive the help he needed. The creativity and determination of that group of friends serve as an inspiration for our Alamance Faith Web.***

Most major community agencies have adopted a collaborative approach called a “System of Care,” which serves children and families by working together in a family-focused team. These teams (CFT’s) assist families in helping their children succeed in home, school, and community by combining front-line professional case management with informal family supports.

### **The Alamance Faith Web is**

An effort by the Alamance Community Collaborative to link agency related Child & Family Teams (CFT) with faith-based organizations who have a desire to serve the needs of children and families in Alamance County.



**The most successful Child & Family Team is one with several natural supports, such as pastors, coaches, teachers, mentors, etc. who take an interest in the family.**

**MISSION:** Enable members of the faith community to partner with Child & Family teams by providing resources, relationships, and ministry programs to children and families who have unmet needs.

1. Touch one family at a time with Divine Love all over Alamance County.
2. To link the Faith Community with families who do not have the necessary spiritual, emotional, or economic resources to succeed at home, school, & community.
